❖ NSS Activities:-

An N.S.S. Unit has been established in the College from this academic year with an initial strength of 50 students under GTU guidance. Prof. J. K. Nathani is coordinating the activities as Program Officer with Prof. V. A. Parikh and Prof. P. H. Lakhani as Assistant Program Officers.

- **Workshop on fire safety:**

Workshop on fire Safety and Rescue Operation with live demonstration was organized by Fire and Safety Wing of the Bhavnagar Municipal Corporation on 22nd July 2014 in the college. The live demonstration created awareness and need of precautions to be taken before the fire fight rescue team arrives on the accident site.



- **Independence Day Celebration:**

- **Visit to CSMCRI, Bhavnagar:**

As a part of celebrating 72nd foundation day of CSIR, its parent organization (Central Salt and Marine Chemicals Research Institute, Bhavnagar) had organized an exhibition with an aim of sparking scientific temper and creating awareness amongst the school/college students. Nearly 156 students of different disciplines from our college visited CSMCRI, Bhavnagar on 26th September 2014 and got knowledge on working model of brackish water desalination RO plant as well as use of bio-diesel, algae, carbon dioxide capture and utilization etc.
