Celebration of 74th Republic Day



NSS Unit: Annual Camp Village: Shampara, Bhavnagar Date: 13/03/2023 to 19/03/2023

Seven days annual camp for NSS volunteers was arranged at Gram Panchayat Office and Primary School of Shampara village during 13 to 19 March 2023. Following activities were carried out during the camp tenure.

NSS Unit provided opportunity to more than 52 students to gain practical skills and exposed to the rural areas this year. Program officer Prof. P. H. Lakhani, and under his guidance students conducted a survey by visiting the different places in village such as school, temple, Health Center, Gram Panchayat Office etc. to make necessary arrangements for the Camp. The representative of the Gram Panchayat helped students to design different activities to be carried out during the camp. Orientation Program for highlighting aims and objectives of arrangement of the camp by illustrating the motto and goals of the NSS.

Day:1 NSS volunteers visited the Gram Panchayat of village Shampara. They discussed common issues and cleanliness of village with Secretary of Gram Panchayat. He briefly explained the work system of a Gram Panchayat. Then, students also visited different sites for different activities during camp.







Day:2 It consisted of Tree Plantation and attaching waterpots (Bird Feeders) for birds at some major public places like Gram Panchayat, Primary School and Temple of Shampara Village.

Volunteer undertook cleanliness drive at the different places in village like schools, surroundings and play area, temple.

Volunteers participated in the march to create awareness about cleanliness among local people and to imbibe it in day-to-day life. Volunteers also instructed villagers about reducing the use of plastic and awareness about it.



Institute and department level Faculty-Students teams worked to coordinate, evaluate and organize the events.





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The institute, as part of its tradition organizes a kind of Annual Festival which includes Technical Events, Cultural Events and Sports Events. The students and the faculty members prepared for the events with a great enthusiasm, zeal and responsibilities.

The Sport-Fest, an inevitable part the annual festival has always been inspiring even for students to show their sporting skills. This year too, there was a whooping response from the students which almost shattered previous records of students' participations. This year totally there were 683 participants in various outdoor and indoor games, from all the engineering branches.

The Sport-Fest included indoor games such as Chess, Carom, Yoga, Table-Tennis which inspired maximum girls' participation. The events of Carom and Chess set a new benchmark as totally there were 164 matches for Carom while for chess total 167 matches were played. The event of the Chess was played in 'League' format, which was really a great example of leadership and team work.

Cricket: always the most popular game of the nation, has the maximum students' participation and there was a grand preparation from the team of faculty and students. Totally 295 students registered to participate in the event of Cricket and there were 13 teams from various semesters and branches. Like every year, the event of Cricket remains the longest running tournament in the Sports Fest-2023.

There were also a few games which required much preparation such as preparing the ground, maintaining the equipment and preparing draws and scheduling matches so that there are minimum clashes.
Volleyball was such a game that required lots of preparation but the fine preparation made the event a great success. Total 187 students were registered for these games.



India is known to be the land of Yoga, it has not only provided a great stage to the Indians but has helped the nation to build an image 'World Yoga Guru'. The students also showed the sincere interest in Yoga. Having the guidance of the qualified Yoga faculty members from the institute, Yoga was a spectacular event. The faculty members from the institute were also invited to 'Judge' the performance of the participants.

'Athletics', the word which redefines the essence of the SSEC-Sports Fest have 370 participations from the institute. The events of Athletics were organized at SAG's prestigious District Sports Complex, which has always garnered the attention of the sport persons of the institute. Having the precious supports from the coaches and trainers of Sports Authority of Gujarat, the events also provided lots of inputs for students. There were events such as 100, 200, 400, 800 and 1600 meter running, Shot-Put, Javelin Throw and Discus throw, High jump and long jump where the students sweated for the success.

Two Indian games; Kabbadi and Kho-Kho have always been the favorites for the students. These events have total registration of 203 boys and 39 girls which also took place at District Sports Complex.




