

It's a pleasure indeed to talk to the present and past students of my alma matter, SSEC. Writing this takes me to a roller coaster ride of about 30 years in the past, where I feel like sharing our memories of joining an Institute, which even didn't have its building, leaving aside other academic infrastructure! Yes, we had a minimal setup of hardly 2-3 classrooms loaned by the Dept. of Physics, Bhavnagar University Campus near Gaurishankar circle. The existing central building of the SSEC at Sidsar Campus was in the final stage of construction, and we moved after completing our first semester. As a part of our NSS unit activity, we were even involved in asset lifting and shifting activity to the new campus. I still remember that first 10-15 kilometres journey in an open R&B Dept. truck with furniture for the first time to the Sidsar campus. Initially, we started with the new central building only. All remaining buildings like workshops, library etc. came later. Even all the labs came later and we used to go to Ahmedabad and Nadiad colleges 4-5 days per semester for our practical.

Bhavnagar, at that time a developing city, and the institute being the first of its kind, was hamstrung with shortage of academic essentials like faculties, books, lab setup, transport etc. and we had to seek possible support from the office of Education Minister of Gujarat at Gandhinagar. Similar persistent and sincere efforts for remaining three and a half years yielded other academic facilities too to an expected level of satisfaction. In a nutshell, our process of becoming an Engineer taught us more about getting difficult things done, which I still feel were equally important as academics. We learned more of practical management.

For one year I happened to be the student council Cultural Secretary and remember laurels we brought to the SSEC in first Bhavnagar University cultural festival we participated, where we won almost all competitions. I recall that this legacy continued for many more years. After graduating, I had an opportunity to join SSEC as a faculty for a small stint of about a year. The grown-up trees you find around the central building these days were planted during this period. II completed my masters from BITS Pilani and later cleared UPSC Indian Engineering Service Examination to join Indian Telecom service, where I am serving since last 25 years. I feel blessed and honoured to be part of the greatest telecom revolution, which has happened in India over last 3 decades where we have moved from number, please facility available only to elite Indian class to free video calling facility in hands of the last Indian citizen. Presently I feel accomplished to head a team, who brought the first Metro Rail to state of Gujarat at Ahmedabad. I feel blessed to have an SSEC alum as my wife, who has supported me all along.

While biding adieu to all of you, I wish to mention that never ever feel that starting from a small, difficult, remote place or environment can hinder your progress. If you dream big and make sincere efforts to achieve it, nothing can stop you. Always have faith that difficult things are always achievable with an open mind, focused vision and hard work.
