• Structure of the Event:

♦The competition is divided into two main rounds:

♦ Round 1 - Online Submission

•In this round, participants are required to submit their content in one of the following formats: PPT, TXT, or PDF.

- •The submitted content should consist of 10 to 20 pages of information related to a topic of the participant's choice.
 - •All participants must register before they can submit their content.
- •The judging panel reviews the online submissions to select the top 14 participants for the next round.

◆ Round 2 - Offline Competition

- •The selected 14 participants from Round 1 are required to be present at the event.
- •During this round, participants have 4 minutes each to orally present the topic they had chosen in their online submissions.
 - •The presentations should be engaging, informative, and well-structured.

•After all 14 participants have presented, a panel of judges will select the top 6 contestants to advance to the main round.

♦ Main Round

- •In the main round, the 6 selected participants will face an exciting challenge. They will be given an alternate topic at the event.
 - •They will have 5 minutes to prepare a presentation on this new topic.
- •Following the preparation time, each participant will have 5 minutes to present their newly assigned topic.
- •The judges will evaluate the participants based on their adaptability, content, presentation skills, and ability to handle unexpected topics.
 - •The winner will be announced immediately after the main round.

• Judging Criteria:

- •Presentation Skills: The ability to engage and captivate the audience through effective verbal delivery, tone, and enthusiasm
- Structure: The organization and coherence of the presentation, including a clear introduction, well-structured main points, and a conclusion that ties everything together.
- Time Management: Demonstrating the ability to stay within the allocated time frame for the presentation, showing respect for the schedule and the audience's time.
- Adaptability: The capacity to adjust the presentation in response to unexpected circumstances, questions, or challenges that may arise during the competition.
- Body Language: The non-verbal cues and expressions that convey confidence, sincerity, and engagement, enhancing the overall impact of the presentation.
- Communication Skill: The effectiveness of conveying ideas, information, and emotions clearly and persuasively, using appropriate language, vocabulary, and tone to connect with the audience.

• Rules:

- All participants must register for the event.
- Participation in all rounds is mandatory.
- In Round 1, participants are required to submit content in PPT, TXT, or PDF format, with a length of 10 to 20 pages.

- In Round 2, participants must be present at the event and are given 4 minutes to present their chosen online topic.
- In the main round, participants will be given an alternate topic at the event and must prepare and present it within 5 minutes.
 - The judges' decisions are final and binding.
 - The winner will be announced immediately after the main round.
