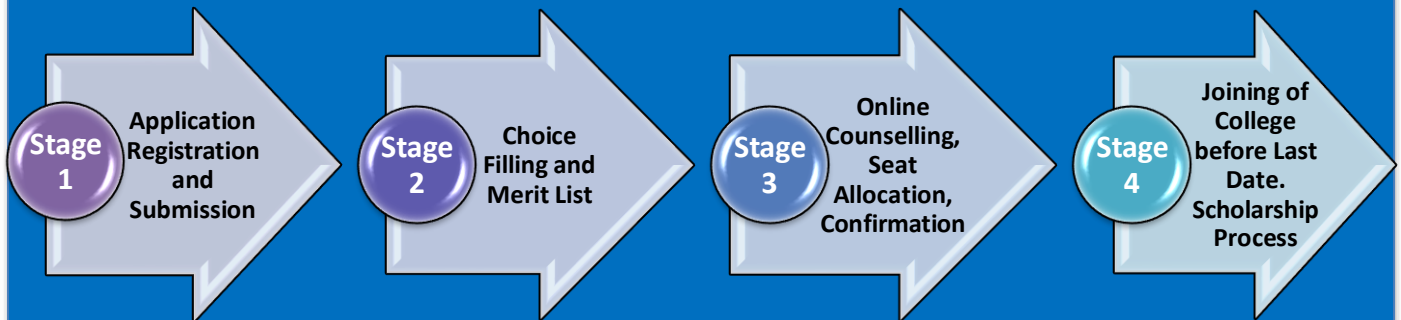

- The release of the monthly instalments would be subject to online verification of student's attendance by the concerned Institute every month. If the absence of student is not communicated before specific date of the concerned month, it will be assumed that student is present for the month and monthly emoluments shall be transferred into students account. The responsibility of not communicating absence of the student shall be vested in the college administration. (Deemed Approval by Institution)
- Academic Fee reimbursable by AICTE shall be at actuals for all the components taken together with a maximum ceiling of **Rs. 1,25,000/- for Professional Streams** which

includes Engineering, Pharmacy, Nursing, HMCT, Architecture; **Rs. 30,000/- for General Stream** and **Rs. 3,00,000/- for Medical Stream to the Institute.**

1. Registration and Application Submission by the Student:

A. 10+2 Scheme

Students who have passed 12th examination from J&K Board or CBSE affiliated schools located in J&K in the academic year 2020-21 and 2019-20 can only submit their application on AICTE Portal for registration. Candidates are advised to fill exact particulars as furnished at the time of registration for class 12th examination. Students whose credentials do not match with the particulars available in AICTE-portal will not be able to register online. On successful registration, eligible students will be issued username and password to fill online form on AICTE Portal.

B. Lateral Entry Scheme

All the eligible diploma passed students in Engineering from the Polytechnic Institutes affiliated with J&K State Technical Board during AY 2019-20 onwards have to follow same procedure for registration, verification of documents and choice filling. The availability of seats is based on the vacancy in AY 2021-22 under PMSSS for Engineering stream only.

2. Document Verification and Choice Filling:

The applicant is required to get her/his uploaded documents verified with the originals at the nearest Facilitation Centres set-up by Government of J&K and once it got verified and uploaded with stamp on portal of Facilitation Centres and then only choice filling window will be activated for only The choice filling window will be blocked on the last date, after that no change will be allowed in order of preference. After document verification from the facilitation center the candidate should collect the copy of document verification report without fail.

3. Seat Allocation by AICTE:

- ❖ Allotment of seat will be done through online counseling only.
- ❖ No admission will be allowed in any circumstances without participation in online counseling process as mentioned above.

- ❖ List of Institutions / Universities has been prepared and is being displayed in candidate's login for choice filling. Eligible students under the Scheme are directed to choose the courses from these Institutions/ Universities only. It may be noted that no scholarship will be paid to the students who take admission in other than the list of Institutions/ Universities available on the portal of AICTE except MBBS/ BDS/BAMS etc. /admission through national level entrance examination for which supernumerary quota is not available.
- ❖ Merit list of students based on the marks obtained in CBSE/JKBOSE will be displayed well before the first round of counseling result.

4. Seat Confirmation/Opting for next Round by the Student:

- ❖ Once the candidate has confirmed her/his seat with respect to allotted course and college, Welcome Letter will be sent from the College login to the candidate.
- ❖ Candidate may contact the Nodal Officer of the Institute to know the joining formalities.

5. Uploading of Joining Report:

- ❖ Candidate will be required to upload the joining report after giving the confirmation of allotted seat, as per prescribed format from her/his login. Candidate who will not upload their joining report on the portal of AICTE on or before the last date of joining, their seats will be cancelled automatically and will be allotted to the students in the next rounds of counselling.
- ❖ The joining report will be verified by the Institute (from Institute Login).
- ❖ The Institute will also verify the bank details and aadhaar number (if any) of the candidate.

Note: The candidate may arrange her/his travel plan accordingly to report to the Institute during working hours to avoid any kind of inconvenience and the same may be shared to Nodal Officer/Allotted College to enable college to make necessary arrangements.

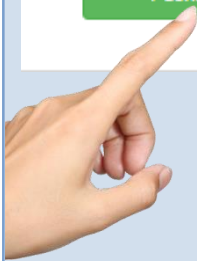

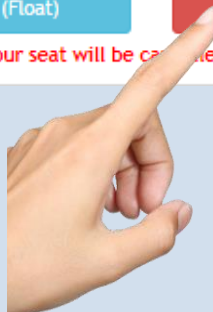

During this step, the choices submitted by the candidates will be processed centrally and seats will be allotted in the order of merit, scheme guidelines and on the basis of the locked choices.

- ❖ The choices filled by the candidates during ONLINE registration will be processed centrally; **hence the candidates are requested to fill their choices carefully.** Online Provisional Admission letter will be generated in the candidate's login account on AICTE website for the candidates who get an allotment in this round. Candidates must

take a print out of this letter and report to the allotted University/ Institute as per the schedule.

- ❖ After the completion of the first round, the vacant seat available will be used for the for next /subsequent round of counselling.
- ❖ In case, a candidate desires to continue in the branch allotted to her/him at the time of admission (i.e. she/he does not want to be considered in subsequent rounds of counseling), then she/he must submit an online request (**FREEZE SEAT**) through AICTE website using candidate's login.
- ❖ It may be noted that "No Scholarship" will be paid to the candidates who take admission in other than the list of Institutions/ Universities available on the portal of AICTE except MBBS/ BDS /BAMS courses/Central/State Govt. for which supernumerary quota is not available.

ONLINE COUNSELING : SECOND ROUND

- ❖ **No fresh registrations shall be allowed in this round.**
- ❖ **The candidates who have opted for the next /subsequent round of counselling shall be considered in this round and also the left over candidates subject to the availability of seats.**
- ❖ It is advised to candidates that they should exercise all the possible choices across Universities/Institutes while filling the choices.
- ❖ Candidates can fill in as much number of choices in the order of preference as they wish to fill, from the list of available choices.

RULES FOR SEAT ALLOCATION TO CANDIDATE

- ❑ The choices submitted by the candidates will be processed centrally and seats will be allotted in the order of merit, scheme guidelines and on the basis of the locked choices, also keeping in view reservation policy.
- ❑ Once the candidate has confirmed her/his seat by using freeze option with respect to allotted course and college, Welcome Letter will be received by her/him from the college itself.
- ❑ Choices filled by candidate would be locked automatically after respective period is over. Prior every round of counseling, choice filling option will be opened based on the vacant seats where candidate can fill their preferences i.e each candidate has to fill fresh choices for next round of counselling.
- ❑ Candidates who have not opted any of the choice for confirming (freeze)/surrendering (float)/ not interested in PMSSS their seat will be cancelled automatically and the same will be offered to the next candidate as per merit and vacancy.
- ❑ If the candidate has opted for the float option with a specific course and college in any round, then she/he will not get the same combination (course & college) during subsequent rounds of counseling.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE

- ❑ **Candidate should positively ensure uploading of joining report on the portal of AICTE** on or before the last date of joining, which will be verified by the Institute, after which DBT application will be opened by the eligible candidates.
- ❑ Candidate who will not upload their joining report on the portal of AICTE on or before the last date of joining, their seats under the scheme will be cancelled automatically and will be allotted to the students in the next/subsequent rounds of counselling (if any).
- ❑ Candidates are required **to report for admission at allotted University / Institution** on the date specified as per the counselling schedule along with the original documents / testimonials / certificates required at the time of admission.
- ❑ Nodal Officer may guide the candidate during her/his stay in the college campus.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ) FOR PMSSS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

1. Who is eligible for PMSSS Scholarship?

Answer - Eligibility criteria under the UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh for PMSSS Scholarship scheme as follows:

1	Domicile	Must be a domicile of UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh
2	Education	HSC Must have passed 10+2 examination in academic session 2020-21 and 2021-2022 only from J&K BOSE only or CBSE schools located in UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh. Lateral Entry (Diploma) Must have passed 10+3 Diploma from UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh Polytechnics are eligible for admission in directly in second year in prescribed list of colleges in the vacant seats of Engineering branch only.
3	Income	Rs. 8.00 Lakh or below per annum (Family Income from all sources)

Only those willing to study outside the UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh

2. I have passed 10+2 in Commerce/Arts stream, am I eligible for Engineering?

Answer- No, but you are eligible for Commerce/Arts stream under General course which are mentioned in the portal. However, you have to qualify Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET) exam conducted by UGC for admission in Central Universities outside J&K and Ladakh.

3. I have submitted my application, is documents verification at Facilitation Centre is necessary?

Answer- Yes, without documents verification at Facilitation Centre created by J&K and Ladakh Government, students are not eligible for Scholarship. Further the choice filling option will not be opened for the respective candidate.

4. Is attending online counseling mandatory for eligible students for availing benefits under PMSSS?

Answer- Yes, it is Mandatory for all the students to attend online counseling process or wants to take admission on his /her own for General/Professional/Engineering stream courses subject to Methodology available on AICTE website, for availing benefits under the scheme PMSSS. For Medical student NEET counseling for availing benefits under the scheme PMSSS. For B.Sc.(Nursing) students, NEET is also mandatory wherever applicable.

5. I have passed 10+2 in Science Stream with Biology, am I eligible for Medical course?

Answer- Yes, for Medical Stream with Biology, the candidate who seeks admission in any of the courses in Medical Stream (MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, etc.) on his/her own merit within the sanctioned intake in any of the institutions recognized by the respective Regulatory Bodies based on the merit at class 10+2 & after qualifying NEET examination. They also need to register during online registration and get their documents verified at the Facilitation Center created by J&K and Ladakh Government only. Please note that AICTE does not provide admission in the Medical Stream, instead the candidate is required to take admission

on their own for availing the scholarship under PMSSS after attending NEET counseling conducted by the respective state Government. It may be noted that no scholarship will be allowed if student is gaining admission through **Management Quota**.

6. I have submitted my online application for PMSSS scholarship. Is it possible to edit my application?

Answer- Yes, officer of Facilitation Centre can only edit the online application form, subject to the production of original documents in support of your claim/request for editing.

7. What is the Scholarship amount for various streams?

8. I am an eligible candidate for PMSSS scholarship. How can I apply for registration of this scholarship?

Answer -Log on to AICTE Website and follow the Steps to apply for “Online Registration for scholarship” and follow the instructions on how to fill the online application.

Step 1: Open AICTE Website via link : <https://www.aicte-india.org/bureaus/jk>

Step 2: Go to PMSSS tab on the home page.

Step 3: Further click on the tab of A/Y 2022-23 and register yourself by following the instructions.

9. What format or size of photo and signature to upload in website for PMSSS Scholarship?

Answer- Both photo & signature should be in .JPG /.PDF/.PNG format with size of the file should be less than 2 MB.

10. Is it necessary to submit separate online application for General & Engineering course?

Answer- Candidates are required to select “**Both**” option from the dropdown menu under “**Stream applied for**” field, if they want to apply for both General & Engineering Stream under J&K PMSSS while submitting online application. The candidate need to fill only one application form.

11. I have filled & submitted my online application form. What should I do next?

Answer-Take printout of online filled application and visit your nearest facilitation centre along with original documents & one set of self-attested photocopies of all original documents for verification. The details are given in AICTE website.

12. To which facilitation centre should I go for document verification?

Answer-You can go to any one of the nearest facilitation centers established by Govt. of UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh as per your convenience for document verification and after that choice filling option would be open. (List of Facilitation Centers is available at AICTE Website).

13. Is there any document I should collect from facilitation centre after document verification process?

Answer- Yes, you must collect document verification report (Student Copy) from the facilitation centre without fail.

14. Is it necessary for me to submit original documents to the facilitation centre after the document verification?

Answer- No original documents are to be submitted in the facilitation centers. However, you have to show all the original documents to the Nodal Officer for verification.

15. Is there any Helpline No./E-mail/Grievance Mechanism for PMSSS Scholarship Queries?

Answer-Yes, you may call on 011-29581043/07/51/10 (from 9.30 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday) or email at jkadmission2022@aicte-india.org on all working days for any queries. You can also register your grievance from your login to get the resolution for your query.

16. I am not able to register under PMSSS scholarship and facing technical issue?

Answer- Any technical issue at the time of registration you may email at itpmsss@aicte-india.org, it2pmsss@aicte-india.org

17. I have done diploma in engineering field, can I apply under PMSSS?

Answer-Yes, Candidates who want to take admission under Lateral Entry Scheme have passed Diploma in Engineering from the Polytechnics recognized by UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh directorate of technical education not earlier than AY 2020-21. Admission under LateralEntry Scheme will be subject to vacant seats available during academic year 2021-22 in Engineering Stream only.

18. I wish to pursue my studies in IIT/NIT/Institute of National Importance/Centrally funded Institutions programs/courses on my own without participating in J&K PMSSS counselingProcess 2022-23, am I eligible for PMSSS scholarship?

Answer- Students who qualify entrance examination conducted by Central Govt. (NEET/JEE) are eligible for scholarships, if they have registered themselves under PMSSS scheme. Candidates are required to get their documents verified by nearest Facilitation Center.

19. Whether, I can take the benefit of other scholarship scheme available for J&K and Ladakh Students alongwith PMSSS Scheme.

Answer: No. All credentials of the applicant will be put to verification on National Scholarship Portal of Government of India for de-duplication. If any student is found to be availing the benefit of other Scheme, his application will be summarily rejected.

20. I wish to pursue my studies in Architecture Course on my own without participating in J&K PMSSS counseling Process 2022-23. Am I eligible for J&K PMSSS scholarship?

Answer- Students taking admission in Architecture course are required to qualify NATA examination and also required to register themselves under PMSSS scheme. Candidates are required to get their documents verified by Facilitation Center.

21. I wish to pursue my studies in MBBS/BDS/Medical etc. Course on my own without participating in PMSSS counseling Process 2022-23 am I eligible for PMSSS scholarship?

Answer- Students taking admission in MBBS / BDS courses etc. are required to qualify NEETexamination, only then they are eligible for scholarship and if they have registered themselves under PMSSS scheme. The candidates are also required to get their documents verified by Facilitation Center.

22. I have taken admission under Management Quota, Am I eligible for PMSSS scholarship?

Answer- No, Candidates taking admission under Management Quota or by Agents / NGO **are not eligible for PMSSS Scholarship.**

23. What all documents do I need to carry at facilitation center for verification?

Answer- Original Documents to be produced at the time of Verification at Facilitation Center are as:

- Xth Standard Mark sheet
- XIIth Standard Mark sheet (if any)
- Diploma Certificate (for lateral entry only)
- Domicile Certificate

- Aadhaar Card (if any)
- Family Income Certificate (Issued by Tehsildar or equivalent)
- Valid Caste certificate for SC/ST/SEBC for claiming the reservation as per State Govt. Policy
- Valid disability Certificate (if any)
- Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET) result
- NEET result for BSc (Nursing programme)

24. How will I get college of my choice?

Answer-As per the choice filled by the candidate and based on merit list, reservation policy of the State and scheme guidelines.

25. Who will be paying the admission fee?

Answer-Academic Fee to the Institution will be disbursed directly by AICTE.

26. What I should do after qualifying NEET examination?

Answer-After qualifying NEET examination, students are required to take admission in Medical/Dental/colleges on their own and then submit NEET Score Card, NEET Counseling Allotment letter after attending state level counselling conducted by respective State Government and joining report on AICTE Portal. They also need to register themselves during online counselling process conducted by PMSSS CELL, AICTE. For details please visit AICTE website. After registration on AICTE Portal, the students have to get their documents verified at the nearest Facilitation Center opened by UTs of J&K and Ladakh (List will be published on AICTE Website_). Please note that AICTE does not provide admission in the Medical Stream, instead the candidate is required to take admission on their own for availing the scholarship under PMSSS.

NOTE: It is decided by the Dental Council of India vide letter No.DE-14-AC-Academic-MDC-2021/1099 dated 23rd July, 2021 that all Private Dental Colleges under its umbrella will not admit more than 5(Five) students per institution under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme with effect from academic session 2021-22. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ) FOR PMSSS SCHOLARSHIP FOR ADMISSION IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

1. I have been allotted a college of my choice, what is the further course of action?

Answer - Once the candidate is allotted any college under PMSSS through online counseling process AY 2022-23, he/she has to provide confirmation on seat with specific time (information will be available on AICTE Portal calendar of events), with respect to allotted course and college by submitting online freezing/floating request through AICTE Website using their login credentials. If candidate failed to do so, within stipulated time period, their seat will be cancelled automatically.

2. I have been allotted the college under PMSSS AY 2022-23, but I am not satisfied with the allotted college/course?

Answer- If the candidate is not satisfied with the allotted college/course & willing to surrender the allotted college/course by knowing the risk involved. He/ She may do so and participate in the next round of counseling for better choice of college/course by using the FLOAT option at his/her own risk. However, there is no guarantee that he/she will get confirmed seat in subsequent rounds of counseling.

NOTE: COLLEGE/BRANCH ONCE SURRENDERED CANNOT BE REVERTED AND WILL BE TREATED AS FINAL.

3. How do I have to provide confirmation on seat?

Answer- The candidate has to give seat confirmation by means of any of the 3 methods:

S.No	Method	Option
1.	If candidate has decided to join the allotted college/course under PMSSS	Press "FREEZE" Option
2.	If candidate is not interested in the given allotment of college/course and wish to participate in next round of counseling	Press "FLOAT" Option
3.	If candidate is not interested to take admission in PMSSSAY2022-23	Press "NOT INTERESTED IN PMSSS"

(This information is to provide within specific time available on calendar of events after the seat allotment and confirmation by the student, allotment letter will be issued / available on student registered login).

NOTE: IF FLOAT OPTION IS SELECTED THEN, SHOWING YOUR SEAT ALLOTMENT IN 1ST ROUND DOES NOT GUARANTEE FOR SAME SEAT OR EVEN SEAT IN NEXT ROUNDS OF COUNSELING AS ALLOTMENT IS PURELY ON MERIT BASIS.

4. I have selected freeze option what is the next step?

Answer—Further upon seat confirmation (FREEZE) candidate may immediately download the provisional allotment letter along with the Welcome Letter of Institute and can connect with the Nodal Officer/ Mentor of AY 2022-23 for additional guidance.

5. I have selected float option what is the next step?

Answer- Once candidate has selected float option a window will open for choice filling with respect to next/ subsequent rounds of counseling. Candidate is requested to select the preferences carefully against vacant seats.

6. When and how do I have to upload my joining report?

Answer- After freezing the seat, candidate is required to report to the allotted college immediately and upload the joining report from his/her PMSSS Login Portal within stipulated time period. Also complete admission process as per Institute/University rules.

7. What is the last date of joining the college?

Answer- Candidate would report physically/virtually (subject to Covid-19 situation from state to state basis) to the Institute on or before last date of admission, along with all the original documents, failing which his/her admission shall be cancelled automatically and seat may be allotted to other aspiring candidate in next/subsequent round of counseling (if any).

8. Where to check the details of my Nodal Officer?

Answer- Candidate can check the details of the Nodal Officer either on the Welcome Letter of the Institute or in their Login.

9. What documents I need to carry while visiting the Institute?

Answer- All candidates who are provisionally allotted a seat in any round of counseling are required to physically report at the respective University/Institute as per the counseling schedule. - xiv. Passed Diploma Certificate from J&K Technical Board (for lateral entry only)
- xv. Reservation Certificate (Caste/Category) as per J& K Govt. Policy (in original, if any)
- xvi. **Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET) qualification letter as per the UGC Notification for admission in Central Universities in General Stream courses.**
- xvii. **NEET qualifying letter for B.Sc. (Nursing programme) wherever mandatory.**
- xviii. **For admission in Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, New Delhi affiliated colleges/ courses for Professional Stream (Engineering Stream only), the students have to qualify JEE Examination and for B.Sc.(Nursing) Programmes, the students have to qualify NEET examination. The copy of the letter is available on AICTE website for information of stakeholders.**

10. I have taken admission in a college on my own and not through PMSSS Counselling on merit basis, am I eligible for the scholarship under PMSSS 2022-23?

Answer - No, a candidate is eligible for the scholarship under PMSSS 2022-23 only if he/she has taken admission in the college through PMSSS 2022-23 on-line counselling process. For details and latest updates please visit AICTE website: <https://www.aicte-india.org/bureaus/jk>

11. I have submitted my application through PMSSS 2022-23 on portal and have taken admission in a Private Dental College on my own and have updated this information under the entrance exam tab in the portal. Will I get the PMSSS scholarship?

❖ **Answer** - It is not guaranteed as it is decided by the Dental Council of India vide letter No.DE-14-AC-Academic-MDC-2021/1099 dated 23rd July, 2021 that all Private Dental Colleges under its umbrella will not admit more than 5(Five) students per institution under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme with effect from academic session 2021-22 onwards. The copy of the letter is available on the portal of AICTE for information of stakeholders. For details and latest updates please visit AICTE website: <https://www.aicte-india.org/bureaus/jk>. It may be noted the no admission in Management quota is allowed under the scheme. In case the number of applicants exceeds 100, merit list of AICTE will be applied.
